#### Love

I Timothy 1:5 But the goal of our instruction is love from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.

I John 3:16-17 We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. But whoever has the world's goods, and beholds his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him?

Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

I Peter 4:8 Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

I Corinthians 13:4-8a Love is patient, love is kind, and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek it's own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong suffered, does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth;

bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails.

I John 4:18-19 There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love. We love, because He first loved us.

I John 4:20,21 If some one says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also.

#### <u>Grace</u>

John 1:17  $^{17}$  For the law was given through Moses, *but* grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

Romans  $5:17^{17}$  For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

Ephesians 1:7  $^7$  In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

Ephesians 2:8 <sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not of works, lest anyone should boast. <sup>10</sup> For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Titus 3:7 <sup>7</sup> that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

2 Peter 3:18 but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory both now and forever. Amen.

### Wisdom

# Health and Peace, Praise and Thanksgiving

Ephesians 4:31-32 Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamour, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. <sup>32</sup> And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

James 1:19-20. Let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; <sup>20</sup> for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

# **Overcoming Doubt**

Psalm 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord, Trust also in Him. And He shall bring it to pass.

Isaiah 26:3 You will keep *him* in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.

Isaiah 55:8-9 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts,

Nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. <sup>9</sup> "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts...

Matthew 19:26 With God all things are possible.

Mark 9:23 Jesus said unto him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him that believe."

Romans 11:33 Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out!

# **Overcoming Discouragement**

Joshua 1:9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

Psalm 27:14 Wait on the Lord; Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the Lord!

Psalm 46:1-3 God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, Even though the earth be removed, And though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea: Though its waters roar and be troubled,

Though the mountains shake with its swelling.

Psalm 61:2 From the end of the earth I will cry to You.

When my heart is overwhelmed; Lead me to the rock that is higher than I.

# Overcoming Guilt and Condemnation

Psalm 103:12 As far as the east is from the west. So far has He removed our transgressions from us.

Isaiah 43:25 "I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

John 8:36 Therefore if the Son makes you free, vou shall be free indeed.

Romans 8:1-2 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

### Diligence

I Corinthians 9:24-25 Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but only one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may win. and everyone who competes in the games exercises self-control in all things. They then do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable.

Colossians 3:23-24 Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men; knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve.

2 Timothy 4:7-8 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith; in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.

Hebrews 12:1-2 Let us lay aside every weight, and the sin, which so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us.

2looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him and und the gross decriping the shape and had

endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

### **Overcoming Resentment**

1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

Ephesians 1:7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.

Ephesians 4:32 And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

Hebrews 12:15 looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled;

## **Humility**

I Peter 5:5-7 All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for God is opposed to the proud but gives grace to the humble. Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time, casting all your anxiety upon Him, because He cares for you.

Matthew 6:1 Beware of practicing your righteousness before men to be noticed by them; otherwise you have no reward with your Father who is in heaven.

2 Corinthians 3:5 Not that we are adequate in ourselves to consider anything as coming from ourselves, but our adequacy is from God.

Luke 14:11For everyone who exalts himself shall be humbled, and he who humbles himself shall be exalted..

Philippians 2:3-5 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself;

do no merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus.

2 Corinthians 12:9 "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness."

Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may dwell in me.

### **Overcoming Failure**

Psalm 37:24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down;

For the Lord upholds him with His hand.

Psalm 103:1 He has not dealt with us according to our sins, Nor punished us according to our iniquities.

Psalm 103:13-14 As a father pities his children, So the Lord pities those who fear Him. <sup>14</sup> For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust.

Habakkuk 3:19 The Lord God is my strength; He will make my feet like deer's feet, And He will make me walk on my high hills.

Philippians 1:6 being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

# **Temptation**

Romans 13:14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to its lusts.

I Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it.

Colossians 3:2-3 Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth. For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

Hebrews 4:15-16 For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin.

Let us therefore draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and may find grace to help in time of need.

James 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt any one.

### Joy and Rejoice

Philippians 4:4-7 Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say rejoice!

<sup>5</sup> Let your gentleness be known to all men. The

Lord is at hand.

<sup>6</sup> Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your request be made known to God;

<sup>7</sup> and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Psalm 16:11Thou wilt make known to me the path of life; in Thy presence is fullness of joy; in Thy right hand there are pleasures forever.

James 1:2-4 Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance And let endurance have its perfect result, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

I Thessalonians 5:16 – 18 Rejoice always; pray without ceasing; in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal, and kill, and destroy; I came that they might have life, and might have it abundantly.

Proverbs 15:13 & 15 A joyful heart makes a cheerful face, but when the heart is sad, the spirit is broken. All the days of the afflicted are bad, but a cheerful heart has a continual feast.

Proverbs 17:21-22 He who begets a fool does so to his sorrow, and the father of a fool has no joy. A joyful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit dries up the bones.

I Peter 1:8-9 And though you have not seen Him, you love Him, and though you do not see Him now, but believe in Him, you greatly rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, obtaining as the outcome of your faith the salvation of your souls.

# **Purity**

2 Timothy 2:20-21 Now in a large house there are not only gold and silver vessels, but also vessels of wood and of earthenware, and some to honor and some to dishonor.

Therefore, if a man cleanse himself from these things he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified, useful to the Master, prepared for every good work.

Romans 12:1 I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

Philippians 4:8 Whatever is true, whatever is honourable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, let your mind dwell on these things.

I Corinthians 6:19-20 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

Romans 6:12-13 Do not let sin reign in your mortal body that you should obey its lusts, and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

Titus 2:11-13 <sup>11</sup> For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, <sup>12</sup> teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, <sup>13</sup> looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Saviour Jesus Christ,

#### **Tongue**

Proverbs 16:24 Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.

Proverbs 12:18 There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.

Proverbs 15:1-2 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh words stirs up anger. The tongue of the wise makes knowledge acceptable, but the mouth of fools spouts folly.

Proverbs 6:16-19 - There are six things which the Lord hates, Yes, seven which are an abomination to Him: Haughty eyes, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises evil plans, feet that run rapidly to evil a false witness who utters lies, and one who spreads strife among brothers.

Proverbs 10:19 In the multitude of words sin is not lacking, But he who restrains his lips *is* wise.

Ephesians 4:29 Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, that it may give grace to those who hear.

Psalm 14:1:3 Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips.

Proverbs 12:25 Anxiety in the heart of a man weighs it down, but a good word makes it glad.

James 1:26 If anyone thinks himself to be religious, and yet does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart this man's religion is worthless.

Proverbs 9:8 Do not reprove a scoffer, lest he hate you, reprove a wise man, and he will love you.

#### Obedience

Romans 13:1 Let every person be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God.

James 4:17 Therefore, to one who knows the right thing to do, and does not do it, to him it is sin.

Hebrews 13:17 Obey your leaders, and submit to them; for they keep watch over your souls, as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you.

Ephesians 6:1–3 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honour your father and your mother (which is the first commandment with a promise), that it may be well with you, and that you may live long on the earth.

Acts 5:29 But Peter and the apostles answered and said, "We ought to obey God rather than men.".

Colossians 3:20 Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well pleasing to the Lord.

Psalm 119:9-1 How can a young man keep his way pure? By keeping it according to your word. With all my heart I have sought You; do not let me wander from Your commandments. Your word have I treasured in my heart, that I may not sin against you.

### Serving

I Corinthians 15:58 <sup>58</sup> Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

I Thessalonians 2:7-9 But we proved to be gentle among you, as a nursing mother tenderly cares for her own children. Having thus a fond affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us. For you recall, brethren, our labour and hardship, how working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God.

I Peter 2:18 -19 <sup>18</sup> Servants, *be* submissive to *your* masters with all fear, not only to the good and gentle, but also to the harsh. <sup>19</sup> For this *is* commendable, if because of conscience toward God one endures grief, suffering wrongfully.

Galatians 5:13-14 For you were called to freedom, brethren; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. For the whole Law is fulfilled in one word, in the statement, "You shall love your neighbour as yourself."

Mark 10:43-45  $^{43}$  Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant.

- <sup>44</sup> And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all.
- $^{45}$  For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Hebrews  $6:10\,^{10}$  For God is not unjust to forget your work and labour of love which you have shown toward His name,  $in\ that$  you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

Joshua 24:14-16 "Now, therefore, fear the Lord and serve Him in sincerity and truth; and put away the gods which your fathers served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the Lord. And if it is disagreeable in your sight to serve the Lord, choose for yourselves today whom you will serve: whether the gods which your fathers served which were beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you are living; but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."

And the people answered and said,

"Far be it from us that we should forsake the Lord to serve other gods."

Psalm 100 Shout joyfully to the Lord, all the earth. Serve the Lord with gladness; Come before Him with joyful singing. Know that the Lord Himself is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with thanksgiving And His courts with praise.

Give thanks to Him: bless His name.

Give thanks to Him; bless His name. For the Lord is good, His loving kindness is everlasting, And His faithfulness to all generations.

Luke 16:13 <sup>13</sup> "No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon."

#### Overcoming Fear

Joshua 1:6 Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.

Joshua 1:7 Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.

Psalm 27:1 The Lord *is* my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord *is* the strength of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid?

Psalm 118:6 The Lord *is* on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me?

Proverbs 3:25-26 The fear of man brings a snare, But whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe.

Isaiah 41:40 Fear not, for I *am* with you; Be not dismayed, for I *am* your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of fear, but of power, of love and of sound mind.

Hebrews 13:6 So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear.
What can man do to me?"

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

God will is for us to mediate on His Word day and night so that we may make our way prosperous and have good success.

Psalm 1:1-6 Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; <sup>2</sup> But his delight *is* in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night. <sup>3</sup> He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper. <sup>4</sup> The ungodly are not so, But *are* like the chaff which the wind drives away. <sup>5</sup> Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. <sup>6</sup> For the Lord knows the way of the righteous,

Col3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

But the way of the ungodly shall perish.
