EMBRACE ADVENTURE:

Being serious about discipleship, willing to take risks, pioneer and move out of the comfort zone of familiar ways of doing things.

We recognise we have a tendency to be cautious and sometimes play it safe. But we want to learn more about taking risks and having the humility to fail well. We want to pioneer and move beyond our comfort zones in order to engage with people who are spiritually hungry.

Starter passages: Matthew 28:18-20, Ephesians 3:20-21, Philippians 4:4-13

INSPIRE OTHERS:

With a generosity of spirit, to energise and motivate people to be all that God created them to be.

Speaking well of each other, blessing one another and encouraging each other. That whenever anyone comes across a Baptist or a Baptist church they leave that encounter inspired to be what God created them to be.

Starter passages: Philippians 4:8-9, Ephesians 4:29-5:2, James 3:1-18, Colossians 3:16-17

SHARE A HUNGER FOR GOD'S COMING KINGDOM:

Nurturing a "holy discontent" that arises from our desire to give practical expression to our vision of God's purpose for creation -- confronting evil, injustice and hypocrisy and challenging worldly attitudes to power, wealth, status and security both within and beyond our Union.

In the way that we are and in the things that we do – challenging evil and injustice and the structures of wealth and power both within and beyond Baptists Together.

Starter passages: Matthew 6:9-10, Luke 4:18-19, Ezekiel 47:1-12

- Is there anything unhealthy we should beware of?
 Or anything God would challenge us on?
- What further steps could we take in this aspect of our life together?
- What other Bible passages come to mind on this topic?
