Catering Arrangements

Coffee and other refreshments will be available to purchase from the Coffee Shop area near the main entrance and will be available throughout Assembly. The in-house coffee shop will be run by members of the Baptist Union Specialist Teams in order to offer best value. All hot drinks offered are supplied by Kingdom Coffee, who promote Fairtrade and fairness. Coffee will be either filtered or instant and a range of tea options will be available. A range of light snacks will also be available together with soft drinks, juices and water - including gluten and dairy free options. Card payments and cash accepted.

During break times, additional stations for purchasing tea, coffee and snacks will be available in the restaurant area on the 1st floor and in the Alexander Suite on the ground floor.

All meals will be served from the Restaurant on the 1st floor. Seating is available to eat your meal in the Restaurant, Coffee Shop (Friday only), Alexander Suite and Herman D Suite. You should have received a ticket when you collected your lanyard that reminds you of your meal choice. Please note that this cannot now be changed.

'Grab bags' will be available for collection on Saturday evening at 19:00. Order forms will be available at the Registration Desk and they need to be returned and paid for at the Coffee Shop on the ground floor by 11:30 on Saturday morning.

FIRST AID

ACCESSIBILITY

People with limited mobility

Bethel Conference Centre is fully accessible, with a lift available to the first floor. If you are a wheelchair user, please ask the Stewards for directions to designated seating locations.

Deaf and the hard of hearing

Hearing dogs are welcome - if you wish to take your dog with you, please ask the Stewards for directions to suitable seats on the aisle. British Sign Language interpreters will be present at all plenary sessions. Bethel Conference Centre has hearing loops in a designated area in the main plenary space. Please ask Stewards to help direct you to this area. If you require any help throughout the day, please speak to one of the team at the Registration Desk.

Visually impaired

Guide dogs are welcome - if you wish to take your dog with you, please ask the Stewards for directions to suitable seats on the aisle. There is a limited number of extra-large print versions of the worship material which, if required, can be obtained from the Stewards or the Registration Desk.

Neurodiverse

If you are feeling overwhelmed at any point and would like to take some time in a quiet room, there is seating available in the Alexander Suite or Herman D Suite on the ground floor. These rooms are available except during our mealtimes.

WORSHIP MATERIAL

Worship material will be projected onto large screens. A small number of large print words will be available from Stewards or the Registration Desk for those with limited vision. If you have difficulty in seeing the screen we would also suggest that you sit to one side and front of the Auditorium.
