Credit Transfer

- If you are studying for a **BA** in and have successfully completed and passed **year 1 (level 4)**, we should be able to grant you exemption from repeating this year.
- If you are studying for a **BA** and have successfully completed and passed up to three modules in **year 2 (level 5)**, we would hope to be able to grant you exemption from repeating these modules (up to a maximum of 60 credits).
- If you are studying for a **Master's degree** and have successfully completed and passed **two modules or more**, we would hope to be able to grant you exemption from up to 60 credits. This is the equivalent of studying for one year part-time.

Pattern of Academic Training

Undergraduate

- Full-time students come to CBC on Wednesday and Thursday during term-time (20 weeks per year).
- Part-time students come to CBC on Thursday only during term-time.

Postgraduate

- Full-time students come to CBC every Friday during term-time (20 weeks per year).
- Part-time student come to CBC approximately every *other* Friday during term-time (depending on modules chosen).

Pattern of Formation Training

- Three intensive weeks, one in September (Leadership), one in January (Practice of Ministry), one in June (Mission).
- Membership of a pastoral group, meeting fortnightly during term-time.
- Supervised placement, and a short Alternative Context Placement.
- For those doing formation *only*, a supervised piece of work relevant each year, relevant to their ministry context.
