



Academic Programmes - validated by Durham Common Awards

Under-graduate Certificate/Diploma/Degree in Theology, Ministry and Mission

- Full time (24 weeks) midweek on Tuesdays and Wednesdays in Manchester (overnight accommodation available)
- **OR** Part time over 7 weekends per year on ZOOM
- Choose from 3 pathways
 - Theology and Practice
 - Community Work and Pioneering
 - Children, Youth and Families (Certificate only)

Post-graduate Certificate/Diploma/Degree in Theology, Ministry and Mission

- Full time or part time
- Options include:
 - Modules delivered on Mondays in Manchester
 - Modules block taught in Summer/Winter Schools (accommodation available)
 - Modules delivered on Mondays on ZOOM

Post-graduate Certificate/Diploma/Degree in Chaplaincy (with the option of including UKBHC accreditation for those interested in working in the NHS)

- Full time or part time
- Delivered entirely on ZOOM (mostly on Mondays)

Please note acceptance onto an academic programme will be dependent on meeting Durham Common Awards criteria for Accredited Prior Learning (APL) or by us applying for special dispensation from Durham Common Awards for you to transfer into the programme depending on your individual circumstances

Ministerial Formation - BUGB Accredited/Open Track/Alternative Track

- Designed to fit around under-graduate academic programme
- **OR** if on a post-graduate academic programme includes some formational modules for audit (in person in Manchester or on ZOOM)
- Placement in local church/pioneering/chaplaincy/community/youth work context set up in partnership with local Baptist association
- Two residential weekends plus a 3-day residential retreat per year
- Formational Tutor Groups in person or on ZOOM
- Individual Tutorials in person or on ZOOM
- Support Group plus 2 visits a year by your personal tutor to see you in your placement context
